Italian Language & Culture in Perugia & Rome



This program, located in Perugia, Italy, begins with a four-day tour in Rome! While in Rome, students will visit ancient ruins such as the Coliseum & the Sistine Chapel. Then, participants will study at the University for Foreigners in Perugia, the ideal location for students who wish to acquire a genuine experience of Italian life, culture, history, and culinary art in a safe, student friendly environment, all while earning 6 academic credits. Students can fulfill the GER in Foreign Language and the GEP in Global Knowledge, saving two foreign language semesters at NCSU. Culture courses are taught in English. No previous Italian experience is needed and no placement test is required!
